Unfortunately, due to the circumstances, we will not be offering any kind of production with rehearsals and live shows as we typically do in the fall. Instead, we have a full schedule of classes (and virtual plays, similar to our summer endeavors) for you to explore. Please note that the capacity of each class can change at any time due to government-issued orders, so we will be as flexible as possible. If, at any point, we are unable to hold classes in-studio, we will be holding them via Zoom to the best of our abilities.

Our classes were designed in the mindset of musical theatre, meaning that each class will not only have a focus on technique and creative expression, but also on its application to the theatre world. For the first half of the semester, there will be an emphasis on the technical side of each class (whether it be dance, acting, writing, or singing), and in the second half students will apply what they learned to create a product for a virtual recital. At the end of this fall semester, each student will be showcased in some way in a virtual showcase, professionally taped and streamed on YouTube Live. Each class has something unique to offer, and we encourage you to read about each one down below! There is something for every interested theatre student, and we offer a discount if you register for more than one class. Classes that have an enrollment of less than three students have the possibility of being cancelled, and classes that surpass an enrollment of more than ten students will have to be split up and add an additional class.
